

# Kaweah MLRP Stakeholder Advisory Committee



## Statement of Purpose

The Stakeholder Advisory Committee plays an important role in the Kaweah Subbasin Multibenefit Land Repurposing Program (MLRP), helping to inform how our community addresses the need to reduce water use while maintaining natural and working lands and providing community benefits. The Committee aims to incorporate diverse perspectives and include representatives from disadvantaged communities, small and disadvantaged farmers and ranchers (SDFRs), tribes, and other interest groups.

The Committee shaped the project selection criteria in the Kaweah MLRP's Request for Proposals, which solicited applications for implementation projects from the region in September, 2023. The Committee also reviewed the project scoring and selections made by Kaweah MLRP partners, shaping the final list of projects recommended to the California Department of Conservation. As the program evolves, the Committee will continue to provide programmatic feedback and inform the development of the Kaweah Multibenefit Agricultural Land Repurposing Plan (MALRP), which will be used to shape land repurposing in the Subbasin beyond the term of the MLRP grant.



## Commitment

Participation in the Committee is voluntary. The estimated time commitment for participation will not exceed 4 hours per quarter for the remainder of the grant period, which ends in March 2026. Stipends and other resources are available to support stakeholder participation.
